YOUR ITINERARY

Day 1—Arrival Day

Pick up at the airport. Introduction to the guides and driver. Transfer to accommodation. Depending on times of arrival we might have an opportunity to visit the famous National Hotel and enjoy one of their famous Mohitos! Otherwise, we will meet and greet over dinner.

Days 2—Day in Havana

We will start the morning with a morning long walking tour of Havana. Havana's Historic Center, the most relevant in the Caribbean, and one of the most outstanding in the Western Hemisphere was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1982. Here you will get in touch with Cuba's colonial history up to the US invasion and occupation of the island in 1898. We will show you the well preserved Historic Center, Plaza De Revolution and take you to the non-restored areas as well.

Day 3—Travel to Viñales B,D

After an early breakfast, we will travel by van to Viñales, and into the Cuban countryside. We will not only enjoy the stunning valley of Viñales and its colorful city, but we will also learn about the traditional methods of growing tobacco that have placed the Cuban Habano as the world's best cigar. Enroute, we will stop at the Jazmines look out point that boasts a beautiful panoramic view of the Valley of Viñales. Lunch will be at a farm-to-table family style restaurant, that has incredible views of the Vinales countryside. Then off to the caves that the Cuban slaves used as hideouts. Lastly, we will have a tour of the community of Vinales, after which, will be treated to a home style dinner.

Day 4—Travel to Las Terrazas

Before leaving Vinales, we will have the morning free with optional activities such as horseback riding or a guided tour through the lush countryside. Then, a late afternoon departure for La Terrazas Bio-sphere Reserve. La Terrazas is a sustainable community and nature reserve designated as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 1984. Currently a flourishing community, the reserve covers 103 square miles of terrain and supports a high concentration of flora and fauna. The community includes artists and farmers where the residency is restricted to preserve the integrity of the commune. There is a vibrant art community with open studios, woodwork and pottery workshops. It is also the site of the earliest coffee plantation. However, the region's main attraction is its verdant natural surroundings, which are ideal for hiking, relaxing and bird-watching.

Day 5—Day of Art and Culture B

This morning on to Jaimanitas, or Fusterlandia, named after Cuban painter and sculptor José Fuster, is a fishing town on the outskirts of Havana. We will travel to Fuster's village where he took over 10 years to flamboyantly rebuild and decorate this sea side village. Jaimanitas is now a Gaudi-esque work of public art where Fuster has refurbished over 80 houses with ornate murals



and the mosaic domes to suit the personality of his neighbors. After, we will stop by the beautiful Parque Al mendares, Havanas largest park fashioned after NYC's Central Park. With a beautiful winding brook, and lush green landscape, one might find people fishing, practicing music, or possibly engaging in a Santeria ritual! Later in the afternoon, the piece de resistance, our very own salsa class. Save your energy, because this evening we will be going to the fabulous La Fabrica (optional), a Cuban art factory touted as the best night activity in Havana! Here we may be able to practice what we learned in our salsa class!



Day 6 — Old Cars and Cigars B

Today we will travel in classic cars to a garage in which the classic cars are brought back to life. Here we will learn how these beauties are restored and the daily challenges faced to keep these oldies running on a wing and a prayer. After, we will tour a government run cigar factory and see the workers rolling cigars. Here, we will be able to compare an efficient government run business to the more rural tobacco entrepreneurs we saw in Viñales.

The afternoon will then be free to explore this incredible City on your own. Maybe you want to visit the incredible Bella Museum of Fine Arts, or spend some time at the Ceramic Museum. Or



possibly use this time to get a few souveniers and have a local beer while listening to some great music!

Day 7—Day of Hemmingway B,D

This morning we'll ride to Cojimar. This was Hemmingway's favorite Cuban fishing town where he wrote for 20 years. Following in his footsteps, we will visit the bars where he drank and fostered his deep connection to the locals and their community. Then, a visit to his villa, *Finca Vigia* (Lookout Farm), which still houses many original furnishings, hunting trophies, and personal artifacts. Afterward we'll travel back to Havana where the afternoon is free. Save your appetite for our farewell dinner where we will say goodbye to our guide and new friends



Day 8—Departure Home
